<b>Size of Estate</b>	46 hectares, 33 planted to vines
<b>Vineyards</b>	Organically farmed Divided into 2 areas: Parcel 1: 15,5 hectares, surrounds the winery's buildings; Parcel 2, called Poggio Piglia, extends over 10,5 hectares and is used for making Chianti Colli Senesi. An additional 7 hectares has been added to Poggio Piglia.
<b>Altitude</b>	450 meters –the highest in the area
<b>Planting density</b>	Between 2,500 and 4,500 vines per hectare
<b>Soil composition</b>	Pliocene origin; volcanic tuff
<b>Grape varieties</b>	Prugnolo Gentile, Canaiolo, Mammolo, Colorino and a small amount of Merlot, Trebbiano and Malvasia
